3. PARKING

Limited permit parking is available for essential Stallholder vehicles located in Botanic Park. No vehicles or trailers will be allowed at the stall site.
  
4. STALL HOLDER RESPONSIBILITIES
  - a) Stalls must be kept clean and tidy. Waste disposal, including liquid waste, is the responsibility of the Stallholder. Stallholders must take waste rubbish to the waste hoppers provided and remove own liquid waste from the site.
  - b) Stallholders must provide fire extinguishers and material (such as cardboard) to protect the ground surface beneath cooking appliances from spillage.
  - c) Stallholders must situate all dangerous appliances, hot barbecues etc. away from public access.
  - d) Please note that power supply is in strictly limited supply. Stallholders are urged to use gas cylinders where possible. 3-phase power is NOT available.
  - e) One light will be supplied in each marquee. Any additional lighting to be supplied by Stallholder.
  - f) Please mark all of your requirements on the attached registration form. Unless ordered in advance, additional power outlets, chairs and trestles will not be available on the day.
  - g) Womadelaide management has overall control of signage, material and products sold or displayed at the event. Please note that any signage, material or products may be refused inclusion entirely at the discretion of the Management.
  - h) Due to current negotiations with potential sponsors, sale of beverages may be strictly controlled.
  - i) Participation in this event is based on agreement to participate in the 'green event' waste management systems. Stallholders are required to serve all food and drink items in 'Womadelaide packaging' at the Botanic Park event site.
  - j) It is your responsibility to ensure that your activity meets Commonwealth, State and Local Government regulations relating to health, fire, safety, vendors licence requirements etc. For details of regulations please contact Jack Darzanof at the Adelaide City Council on 08 8203 7416.
